

HOW TO BECOME A **TEACHER!**

PRE-PROGRAM

Start!

2. Start gaining experience in the classroom as an Instructional Aide or Substitute Teacher.

1. Earn a bachelor's degree.

3. Decide what grade levels and subjects areas of education you'd like to pursue.

4. Begin researching preparation programs or study guides for the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification.

5. Study!

YEAR 1

9. Once enrolled, complete Phase 1, or any pre-classroom modules to gain your Interim Teaching Certificate.

8. Once you have picked the program that works best for you, apply online.

7. Now that you've passed the necessary tests, beginning researching alternative route programs.

6. Schedule your MTTC testing date(s) for any exams you plan on taking.

YEAR 2-3

10. With your Interim Teaching Certificate you may begin working in the classroom as a Teacher!

11. Continue online coursework through year 1.

12. During year 2 and 3, continue with your alternative route program's process of cohort meetings and mentorship.

Finish!

13. After 3 years of effective teaching, your program will recommend you for your Michigan Standard Teaching certificate with the Michigan Department of Education!
