



Hello Bradford Community,

Today April 12, we have confirmed that an individual in our K-8 school building has tested positive for COVID-19. Upon confirmation, the proper Oakland County Health Department (OCHD) and district recommendations were followed to quarantine the individual diagnosed with COVID-19 and identify any potential close contacts. Administration has completed the school portion of the case investigation and all individuals identified as close contacts have been contacted.

In review of current COVID numbers and taking under consideration of the current Director of the CDC for Michigan to shutdown, we will be pausing in-person learning and moving to 100% virtual learning starting on **Tuesday, April 13 2021** and continuing through **Monday, April 26 2021**. School will resume in-person **Tuesday, April 27 2021** pending review and board approval. All scheduled state testing what would have taken place in the next two weeks will be put on pause.
