



Dear Bradford Academy High School Parents/Guardians,

Please read this letter in its entirety.

Bradford Academy High School is acting on the governor's most recent recommendation, and **going virtual for two weeks, starting on Monday, April 12.** The school building will be closed starting on Monday, April 12 and will re-open at 7:30 am on Monday, April 26, 2021. We will return to in-person learning on Monday, April 26. The elementary and middle school will remain in-person with the current health and safety precautions.

Additionally, all sports will be cancelled for the next two weeks, beginning Monday, April 12. More information regarding sports and the ability to return to events will be discussed in the coming days.

As stated on Tuesday evening, we were informed of a positive case at Bradford Academy in the high school. Proper protocol and tracing has taken place and families with potential exposure have been contacted. Today, we were informed of another potential positive case, and close contacts will be contacted individually.

As always, we are committed to providing a safe environment for all our students and staff. The decision to go virtual was made because of the Governor's most recent address Friday morning, strongly advising all Michigan high schools to pause in-person instruction for two-weeks due to the rise in COVID cases.

We encourage you to continue monitoring your child's health and take precautions when possible. Please inform Mr. Edwards or me if your student begins experiencing virus or flu-like symptoms, including fever, cough, sneezing, or sore throat, or they test positive for COVID-19.
